Thanks for registering for the 2017 Tiny Hearts Farm Flower CSA, hosted by Allandale Farm. Please review and sign this CSA agreement that includes guidelines and expectations for participation in this CSA. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us at csa@allandalefarm.com.

What is a Flower CSA? A flower CSA works the same way as a veggie CSA. Members purchase a share of the coming season's flower harvest. Typically, the consumer pays early in the season, which helps the farm buy seeds, and other supplies for the year. In return for their investment, members receive a good value for a weekly bouquet of organically grown flowers. This is a great way to showcase the gorgeous flowers of our region and keep a fresh bouquet of flowers on your table all season long.

Who is Tiny Hearts Farm? Tiny Hearts Farm is a family-run organic flower farm located on 15 acres in Copake, NY. Check out their beautiful Instagram account @tinyheartsfarm to see what this farm is all about (a new website is coming soon!).

This season at Allandale, we are focused on our commitment to providing the highest quality, and largest diversity of crops. In doing so, we decided to scale back our cut flower program and forgo our own flower CSA. Enter our friends at Tiny Hearts Farm! They are truly committed to gorgeous cut flowers. We're so excited that we get to share all their hard work with you, and offer a high quality flower CSA option.

Start Date: The beginning of the Flower CSA will be on or around the last week of June. We ask for some flexibility due to the unpredictability of the Northeast's spring weather. You will receive an email notification at least 10 days in advance of the first pick up date.

Pick Up Time & Day: Our friends at Tiny Hearts Farm will be arranging your bouquets the morning of pickup and delivering them to Allandale, where we are able to store them in our walk-in until the end of the day on Tuesday. Bouquet pick-up is on Tuesday during designated pick-up hours only (2-7PM) to ensure highest quality. Unclaimed shares will be donated to Lovin' Spoonfuls (www.lovin Spoonfulsinc.org) each week. If you can't pick-up, please feel free to have someone pick-up for you.

Pick Up Location: Shares will be available for pick up in the garage behind the farm store. Please be prepared to provide the last name under which the share is registered (for simplicity, please assign only one name to each share).

Parking: Parking is available in the main parking lot just off of Allandale Road in front of the farm store. **Please do not drive up to the garage** as that space is used for vendor deliveries, farm vehicles, tractor repairs, and summer camp congregation.

I understand that by registering I accept the inherent risks and rewards of participating in a CSA program. By signing, I acknowledge that agriculture is unpredictable and I will not receive a refund for any crop losses or failures.
